Therefore, their use should be compulsory.</p> <p>Second, air pollution in cities must be reduced for citizens’ health. Private vehicles create much of the pollution in cities, so people should be forced to use public transportation instead. If everyone does, much less harmful gas will be released.</p> <p>In conclusion, for the above two reasons, people in cities should be required to use public transportation. It will not be easy, but it is necessary to save money and to reduce dangerous pollution.</p>
